STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

CRITERIA

1. Northview High School senior in good standing.
2. A letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, school administrator, etc. or any other adult not related to you who can best describe your accomplishments and potential for enriching others.
3. Admission to WESTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY 2021
4. Have attended Northview Public School for the previous 4 years.
5. Completion of a minimum 500 Word Essay on the following theme:

Theme: Character

As Defined by Merriam-Webster, "*Character is the way someone thinks, feels, and behaves.*" Essentially, it's what makes you who you are.

Describe a time in your life that has shaped who you are as a person.

6. APPLICATION DEADLINE IS APRIL 23, 2021.

This scholarship is a three year scholarship totaling \$10,000.

This winner of this scholarship will receive \$5000 the first year (August 1, 2021).

To receive the second installment of \$2500, the winner must submit a transcript from WMU stating the student is in good GPA standing of 2.5. This must be submitted to NEF by June 15. August 1, 2021 the student will receive \$2500 if the criteria is met.

To receive the third installment of \$2500, the winner must submit a transcript from WMU stating the student is in good GPA standing of 2.5. This must be submitted to NEF by June 15. August 1, 2022 the student will receive \$2500 if the criteria is met.
